For lots of kids, summer usually means more outdoor fun like swimming, camping, playing tag or riding bikes. With the warmer weather and longer days, your kids may never want to come back inside! That means it's extra important to keep an eye on your children during this time.

Keep your kids summer healthy by making sure they do not get dehydrated. With all the outdoor-fun, kids can forget to drink liquids. Do simple things like keeping water bottles full and at your child's reach. Also make sure kids avoid being outside during the midday HEATWAVE. You can do crafts inside that your kids will love when it's too hot to play outside.

Being outside in the sun means more sunscreen is needed. Many parents forget that kid's skin is more sensitive to the sun. So, it's always a good idea to have kids wear a hat and put on a thick layer of sunscreen, even on a cloudy day. If possible, have your kids play in the shade.
